**AN ACT PERMITTING EACH INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION  
THAT IS PART OF THE CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM  
AND THE REGIONAL COMMUNITY-TECHNICAL COLLEGE SYSTEM  
TO APPOINT, REMOVE AND FIX THE COMPENSATION OF THE  
CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF SUCH INSTITUTION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10a of the general statutes be amended to permit each
- 2 institution of higher education that is part of the Connecticut State
- 3 University System and the regional community-technical college
- 4 system to appoint, remove and fix the compensation of its chief
- 5 executive officer.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide each institution of higher education with the autonomy to  
hire, fire and compensate its own president.
