AN ACT CONCERNING INFANT SAFE SLEEP PRACTICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 368v of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 hospitals to provide informational materials regarding recommended
- 3 safe sleep practices for infants, including American Academy of
- 4 Pediatrics recommendations concerning safe sleep practices, to parents
- 5 after the birth of a child at the hospital.

Statement of Purpose:

To facilitate and encourage safe sleep practices and prevent avoidable infant deaths.
