AN ACT REQUIRING THE STATE OMBUDSMAN TO INVESTIGATE COMPLAINTS CONCERNING RECIPIENTS OF HOME AND COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 17a-408 of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 the Office of the Long-Term Care Ombudsman to investigate
- 3 complaints concerning recipients of home and community-based
- 4 services.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand the scope of the State Ombudsman's duty to protect long-term care clients to those receiving home and community-based care.
