AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONNECTICUT JUVENILE TRAINING SCHOOL ADVISORY GROUP.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 17a-6b of the general statutes be amended to (1) create a
- 2 Connecticut Juvenile Training School board to replace the current
- 3 advisory group, the members of which shall be appointed by the
- 4 Governor and legislative leaders, (2) expand the jurisdiction of such
- 5 board to include oversight of the Pueblo Unit for girls, (3) empower
- 6 such board to have access to the Connecticut Juvenile Training School
- 7 and the Pueblo Unit for girls and all Department of Children and
- 8 Families records relating to such facilities, (4) empower such board to
- 9 make recommendations to the Department of Children and Families
- 10 regarding improvements to such facilities, (5) require such board to
- 11 annually report to the committees on judiciary, human services and
- 12 children on its findings and recommendations and to hold a public
- 13 hearing regarding such findings and recommendations.

Statement of Purpose:

To strengthen oversight of the Connecticut Juvenile Training School and Pueblo Unit for girls.
