**AN ACT CONCERNING THE SERVICE AND CONSUMPTION OF
ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR AT BOWLING ESTABLISHMENTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (c) of section 30-91 of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to allow the service and consumption of alcoholic liquor
- 3 throughout the premises of a bowling alley, and not just in the area on
- 4 the permit premise that is located in a separate room or rooms entry to
- 5 which, from the bowling lane area of the establishment, is by means of
- 6 a door or doors that is closed at all times except to permit entrance and
- 7 egress to and from the lane area.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow the service of alcoholic liquor throughout a bowling alley.
