**AN ACT ASSISTING STUDENTS ACCEPTED INTO THE DEFERRED
ACTION FOR CHILDHOOD ARRIVALS PROGRAM WITH THE COST
OF COLLEGE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 That title 10a of the general statutes be amended to allow any
2 student who has been accepted into the federal government's deferred
3 action for childhood arrivals program to receive certain types of
4 financial assistance for attending an institution of higher education in
5 this state, including, but not limited to, assistance from the funds set
6 aside by a constituent unit from the anticipated tuition revenue of the
7 institutions of higher education under its jurisdiction that are used to
8 provide tuition waivers, tuition remissions, grants for educational
9 expenses and student employment for residents of this state enrolled
10 as full or part-time matriculated students in a degree-granting
11 program, or enrolled in a precollege remedial program who
12 demonstrate extreme financial need.

Statement of Purpose:

To assist students accepted into the federal government's deferred
action for childhood arrivals program with the cost of college.
