AN ACT CONCERNING THE ZERO TOLERANCE ENVIRONMENT ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide for a zero tolerance
- 2 environment in which the penalty for making a threat of violence
- 3 against a school is increased to a felony with a mandatory fine,
- 4 provided if the person charged is deemed to suffer from mental illness,
- 5 the courts shall make mental health assistance available.

Statement of Purpose:

To pass the Zero Tolerance Environment Act.
