AN ACT CONCERNING AN EXAMINATION OF FIRE SAFETY ISSUES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the Legislative Program Review and Investigation Committee
- 2 (1) study fire safety issues including, but not limited to, (A) general
- 3 compliance with the annual inspection requirement in subsection (b) of
- 4 section 29-305 of the general statutes, (B) variations in compliance and
- 5 timeliness of such inspections among municipalities, (C) whether the
- 6 failure to conduct timely inspections contributed to any serious fire or
- 7 fire involving a fatality, and (D) factors that prevent the completion of
- 8 such inspections, and (2) make recommendations to improve
- 9 enforcement of the Fire Safety Code and assist local fire marshals in
- 10 meeting their inspection obligations.

Statement of Purpose:

To study fire safety and compliance with fire safety inspections.
