**AN ACT CONCERNING MUNICIPAL REGULATION OF
SNOWMOBILES AND ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That Section 14-390m of the general statutes be amended to allow
2 any municipality to adopt an ordinance regulating the operation and
3 use, not only of dirt bikes, but also of snowmobiles and all-terrain
4 vehicles, with the same penalties for violations, and adding a provision
5 that, for a third or subsequent violation of a municipal ordinance, the
6 ordinance may provide for the seizure and forfeiture to the
7 municipality of such dirt bike, snowmobile or all-terrain vehicle,
8 subject to any bona fide lien, lease or security interest in the dirt bike,
9 snowmobile or all-terrain vehicle, including, but not limited to, a lien
10 under section 14-66c of the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To permit a municipality to adopt an ordinance regulating the use or operation of a dirt bike, snowmobile or all-terrain vehicle that provides for seizure and forfeiture of the dirt bike, snowmobile or all-terrain vehicle to the municipality for a third or subsequent violation.
