AN ACT REQUIRING TOW TRUCK OPERATORS TO CLEAN ROAD DEBRIS LEFT AFTER AN ACCIDENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require all tow truck
- 2 operators, who remove a motor vehicle from the scene of an accident,
- 3 to remove and dispose of all glass, metal and other debris that has
- 4 been cast upon the public highways as a result of such accident. The
- 5 tow truck operator shall follow the direction of the police or fire officer
- 6 at the scene and shall not depart the scene until all debris has been
- 7 removed and the operator has been released by the officer. If the area
- 8 is not properly cleaned, the police may require the operator to return
- 9 to the scene of the accident to complete cleaning up.

Statement of Purpose:

To require tow truck operators to clean up all debris left behind after a motor vehicle accident.
