**AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN REVISIONS TO THE CALCULATION OF
THE MINIMUM BUDGET REQUIREMENT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That subsection (d) of section 10-262i of the general statutes be
2 amended to (1) remove special education costs from the calculation of
3 a town's minimum budget requirements, (2) repeal the limit that a
4 school district may reduce its budgeted appropriation for education in
5 an amount not to exceed one-half of one per cent of the district's
6 budgeted appropriation for education when a district experiences a
7 decline in the number of resident students, and (3) increase the
8 multiplier from three thousand to six thousand in the calculation
9 allowing a town to reduce its budgeted appropriation for education
10 when the number of resident students of such town decreases.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide relief to municipalities by reforming the calculation of a town's minimum budget requirement.
