AN ACT REPEALING THE REQUIREMENT THAT TOWNS BE FINANCIALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR INTERDISTRICT MAGNET SCHOOL TUITION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 172 of the general statutes be amended to eliminate the
- 2 requirement that towns pay tuition to interdistrict magnet school
- 3 operators and regional educational services centers for the operation of
- 4 interdistrict magnet schools and to require the state to pay such
- 5 tuition.

Statement of Purpose:

To remove local costs associated with interdistrict magnet school tuition.
