**AN ACT PROHIBITING CERTAIN JOINT CAMPAIGNING BY  
CANDIDATES FOR GOVERNOR AND LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR  
UNDER THE CITIZENS' ELECTION PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 157 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit
- 2 candidates for the offices of Governor and Lieutenant Governor, prior
- 3 to any primary for such offices, from jointly campaigning for the
- 4 purpose of calculating contribution amounts qualifying such
- 5 candidates for grants under the Citizens' Election Program.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To prevent the preprimary unification of campaigns for Governor and  
Lieutenant Governor for purposes of qualifying for grants under the  
Citizens' Election Program.
