**AN ACT CONCERNING ENHANCED MONITORING OF CERTAIN PAROLEES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to: (1) Authorize local police
- 2 officers to temporarily hold in custody a parolee if such parolee has
- 3 committed an act of a serious nature that would constitute a violation
- 4 of the terms of his parole; (2) require such officer to notify such
- 5 parolee's parole officer within seventy-two hours of taking such
- 6 parolee into custody; and (3) require that any parolee taken into
- 7 custody under this section for an act that would constitute a technical
- 8 violation of parole shall only be held in custody until such time as the
- 9 police officer can notify the parolee's parole officer.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To promote public safety by enhancing parole enforcement.
