***AN ACT CONCERNING TRAINING IN CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-16b of the general statutes be amended to (1) require
- 2 training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation be included in the program
- 3 of instruction at public high schools, and (2) allow local and regional
- 4 boards of education to accept gifts, grants and donations to purchase
- 5 materials for such training.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To increase the number of people in the state who are trained in the life-saving methods of CPR.
