**AN ACT EXCLUDING OVERTIME PAY FROM THE CALCULATION OF
STATE EMPLOYEE PENSION BENEFITS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit any pay for
- 2 overtime accumulated after passage of this act from being considered
- 3 "salary" for the purposes of calculating pension benefits for any state
- 4 employee.

Statement of Purpose:

To end pension padding by providing that overtime pay may not be
used to increase pension benefits for state employees.
