**AN ACT CONCERNING RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE SCHOOL NURSE ADVISORY COUNCIL.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-212 of the general statutes be amended to (1) require
- 2 local and regional boards of education to maintain a staffing ratio of
- 3 one school nurse or nurse practitioner for each seven hundred fifty
- 4 students, (2) permit a school nurse or nurse practitioner to provide
- 5 services to one or more local or regional boards of education as long as
- 6 the staffing ratio requirement is met, and (3) require school nurses and
- 7 nurse practitioners to complete the school nurse orientation program
- 8 offered by the State Department of Education and the Association of
- 9 School Nurses of Connecticut not later than one year after being hired
- 10 by a local or regional board of education and meet the educational
- 11 requirements and other qualifications specified in regulations adopted
- 12 by the State Board of Education.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To adopt the recommendations of the School Nurse Advisory Council.
