AN ACT CONCERNING A BLASTING STUDY BY THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Fire Marshal be required to study the use of explosive
- 2 agents and blasting in the state, review the existing statutes and
- 3 regulations and make recommendations regarding the use of explosive
- 4 agents and blasting to ensure public safety and abatement of any
- 5 hazard in a report to be submitted to the joint standing committee of
- 6 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to public
- 7 safety.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the State Fire Marshal to study the use of explosive agents and blasting.
