***AN ACT CONCERNING THE INCLUSION OF INVESTIGATIVE  
DETENTION AND ARREST TO THE SOCIAL STUDIES CURRICULUM.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-16b of the general statutes be amended to include as
- 2 part of the social studies curriculum for students in grades six to
- 3 twelve, inclusive, instruction about investigative detention and arrest
- 4 and to permit law enforcement officers to provide such instruction
- 5 when appropriate.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To ensure the safety of our children, the public and the police during instances of investigation and arrest by providing instruction on investigation and arrest to students.
