**AN ACT CONCERNING WRITTEN NOTICE REQUIREMENTS FOR
HOMEMAKER OR COMPANION SERVICES REGISTRIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 20-679a of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
3 *October 1, 2015*):

4 (a) Not later than [seven] four calendar days after the date on which
5 a registry supplies, refers or places an individual with a consumer, the
6 registry shall provide the consumer with a written notice, to be signed
7 by the consumer, specifying the legal liabilities of such registry to the
8 individual supplied or referred to or placed with the consumer. If the
9 registry maintains an Internet web site, a sample of the notice shall be
10 posted on such Internet web site.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

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Statement of Purpose:

To reduce the number of days in which a homemaker or companion services registry is required to provide a consumer with written notice specifying the legal liabilities of the registry.
