***AN ACT CONCERNING OVERSIGHT WITHIN THE DIVISION OF
CRIMINAL JUSTICE.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 51-277 of the general statutes is amended by
2 adding subsection (e) as follows (*Effective October 1, 2015*):

3 (NEW) (e) The Chief State's Attorney shall supervise the division,
4 including the state's attorney for each judicial district.

5 Sec. 2. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2015*) Not later than March first of
6 each year, the state's attorney for each judicial district and each state's
7 attorney that assists the Chief State's Attorney shall submit a written
8 report to the Chief State's Attorney. Such report shall include (1) any
9 recommendations for (A) a statutory change, or (B) a budget proposal
10 that may assist the Division of Criminal Justice's ability to investigate
11 and prosecute criminal matters, and (2) any merit and performance
12 rating prepared pursuant to section 51-280 of the general statutes by
13 such state's attorney during the previous calendar year.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Sec. 2	<i>October 1, 2015</i>	New section
