

Dear Legislators,

I am writing to voice my **OPPOSITION** to House Bill 6818, an Act Concerning The Establishment of Electronic Tolls At The State's Borders.

I travel out of state daily to my job in Worcester, Massachusetts. Establishing tolls on the border will

- 1) Place an additional financial BURDEN on my family that will be difficult to bear in these economic times,
- 2) INCREASE the traffic and congestion at the border, and
- 3) DECREASE my safety as I travel through these toll lanes.

I am already paying 25 cents per gallon of gasoline and an 8.1% gross receipts tax to support our transportation infrastructure!
