"AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE 30, 2017, AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS THEREFOR, AND OTHER PROVISIONS RELATED TO REVENUE, DEFICIENCY APPROPRIATIONS AND TAX FAIRNESS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT."

1 Strike sections 93 and 170 in their entirety and renumber the
2 remaining sections and internal references accordingly

3 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
4 internal references accordingly:

5 "Sec. 501. (Effective July 1, 2015) (a) The State Comptroller shall
6 achieve savings in the medical insurance plan for state employees in
7 the amount of \$10,000,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, and

8 the amount of \$15,000,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, by
 9 requiring prior authorization for prescriptions requiring the
 10 compounding of pharmaceuticals. Any such savings shall be credited
 11 to the resources of the General Fund.

12 (b) Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes, no state
 13 agency shall employ more than one deputy commissioner during the
 14 fiscal year ending June 30, 2017. Any savings achieved from the
 15 provisions of this subsection shall be credited to the resources of the
 16 General Fund.

17 Sec. 502. (*Effective July 1, 2015*) Up to \$2,500,000 in each of the fiscal
 18 years ending June 30, 2016, and June 30, 2017, from the savings
 19 achieved and credited to the resources of the General Fund in section
 20 501 of this act shall be made available to fund state resident policemen
 21 for regular assignment to towns, or two or more adjoining towns, in
 22 accordance with the current provisions of subsection (a) of section 29-5
 23 of the general statutes."
