3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective October 1, 2015*) The provisions of this act
4 concerning a person who is convicted of a violation of section 21a-279
5 of the general statutes, as amended by this act, shall not be construed
6 in a manner that changes such person's eligibility to hold a certificate
7 under sections 7-294d, 29-36f and 29-37p of the general statutes, as
8 amended by this act, or a permit under section 29-28 of the general
9 statutes, as amended by this act, or such person's ability to possess a
10 firearm, ammunition or an electronic weapon under sections 53a-217
11 and 53a-217c of the general statutes, as amended by this act."
