"AN ACT PROHIBITING MANDATORY REGISTRATION FOR CERTAIN CONSUMER WARRANTY COVERAGE."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2015*) (a) For purposes of this
4 section, (1) "Express warranty" means a written statement arising out
5 of a sale to a consumer of consumer goods pursuant to which the
6 manufacturer, distributor or retailer undertakes to preserve or
7 maintain the utility or performance of the consumer goods, or provide
8 compensation if there is a failure in utility or performance, and (2)
9 "consumer goods" means goods that are used or bought for use
10 primarily for personal, family or household purposes.

11 (b) Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes, no
12 manufacturer, distributor or retailer that makes an express warranty
13 with respect to a consumer good may condition the initial term of such
14 express warranty on the consumer registering such consumer good."
