**"AN ACT CONCERNING IN-STATE TUITION ELIGIBILITY."**

- 1 Change the effective date of section 1 to "Effective July 1, 2016"
- 2 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
- 3 internal references accordingly:
- 4 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2016*) Notwithstanding any
- 5 provision of the general statutes and to the extent permitted by federal
- 6 law, no person shall qualify for any state financial assistance or state
- 7 benefit until such person has resided in the state for two years or
- 8 more."
