"AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO STUDY LIFE-THREATENING FOOD ALLERGIES IN SCHOOLS."

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- 1 Strike lines 1 to 20, inclusive, and insert the following in lieu thereof:
- 2 "Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established a task force
- 3 to study life-threatening food allergies in schools. The task force shall
- 4 examine (1) the efficacy of the implementation, dissemination and
- 5 enforcement of the guidelines for the management of students with
- 6 life-threatening food allergies and glycogen storage disease, developed
- 7 by the Department of Education pursuant to section 10-212c of the
- 8 general statutes, (2) methods used by school districts to ensure the
- 9 safety of students with life-threatening food allergies while such
- 10 students are being transported to and from school, (3) the plans for the
- 11 management of students with life-threatening food allergies and
- 12 glycogen storage disease, implemented by local and regional boards of

13 education pursuant to section 10-212c of the general statutes, to ensure
14 the safety of students with life-threatening food allergies and their
15 inclusion as fully participating members in the school community, (4)
16 the emotional and psychosocial welfare of students with life-
17 threatening food allergies as it relates to and is influenced by such
18 students' membership in the school community and how such students
19 are included or excluded from participating in school events, and (5)
20 how instances of isolation or targeting of students with life-threatening
21 food allergies by other students, school staff or school policy are
22 addressed by the school or district administration."

23 Strike lines 28 and 29 in their entirety and insert the following in
24 lieu thereof:

25 "one of whom shall be the parent or guardian of a student with a
26 life-threatening food allergy enrolled in a public school in the state;"
