**"AN ACT CONCERNING REPORTING REQUIREMENTS OF THE
UNIVERSITY OF CONNECTICUT AND THE BOARD OF REGENTS
FOR HIGHER EDUCATION REGARDING FINANCIAL AID."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) Notwithstanding the
4 provisions of sections 10a-6 and 10a-72 of the general statutes, the
5 Board of Regents for Higher Education shall not (1) close, authorize the
6 closure of or proceed with any closure authorized prior to the effective
7 date of this section of any campus of a public institution of higher
8 education within its jurisdiction, or (2) suspend, authorize the
9 suspension of or proceed with any suspension authorized prior to the
10 effective date of this section of any manufacturing program offered by
11 a public institution of higher education within its jurisdiction, without
12 the approval of the General Assembly.

13 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 10a-72 of the general
14 statutes, a public institution of higher education within the jurisdiction
15 of the Board of Regents for Higher Education shall not (1) close or
16 proceed with any closure authorized prior to the effective date of this
17 section of any of its campuses, or (2) suspend or proceed with any
18 suspension authorized prior to the effective date of this section of any
19 of its manufacturing programs, without the approval of the General
20 Assembly."
