

Testimony to Appropriations Committee in support of CEQ re: 3-2-15 Public Hearing

To survive, the Council on Environmental Quality needs to retain its present funding (\$187,000). It also must remain independent. The Governor proposed moving CEQ to the General Assembly's Legislative Management Committee and Department. That might be done without a loss of independence, but would be more expensive and less efficient than allowing CEQ to remain in its present offices at DEEP.
