Title: AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE CONCERNING CANDIDATE COMMITTEES.

Statement of Purpose: To (1) require that all candidates provide a signature in order to accept an endorsement, (2) require that minor party candidates, petitioning candidates and write-in candidates reside in the district represented by the office they seek, and (3) eliminate discretionary supervised balloting.
