Title: AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR PARTY CANDIDATE CERTIFICATIONS.

Statement of Purpose: To (1) remove the requirement that a person nominated by a minor party as a candidate for elective office must sign the nomination form to be filed with the Secretary of the State or the clerk of the municipality, as the case may be, and (2) ensure such person is made aware that he or she has been so nominated and can accordingly, under section 9-460, decline such nomination by advising the Secretary or clerk, as the case may be, of his or her withdrawal.
