Title: AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROTECTION OF PARTICULARLY VULNERABLE CHILDREN.

Statement of Purpose: To require the Commissioner of Children and Families, in consultation with the Office of Early Childhood, the Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, the Department of Public Health, the Office of the Child Advocate and the child fatality review panel, to conduct a study regarding the current policies and procedures used to protect particularly vulnerable children in the state from unexpected death or critical injury.
