Title: AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS TO THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE STATUTES, AND CONCERNING THE PSYCHIATRIC SECURITY REVIEW BOARD, DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATIONS AND DEPOSITIONS OF PERSONS LIVING OUT-OF-STATE.

Statement of Purpose: To clarify that the period of probation for an incarcerated individual begins after the completion of the period of incarceration in response to the ruling in State v. Moore, to facilitate the return to Connecticut of fugitive defendants in criminal cases who have absconded to another jurisdiction after having bond posted through a bail bond agent, to include home invasion as a predicate offense to the crime of felony murder, to provide an appropriate penalty for assault that results in serious physical injury, to clarify that the ten-year period of registration for certain sexual offenders commences after any term of incarceration is completed, to provide for a more appropriate means of disposition in certain cases of simple trespass and to amend the statutes concerning tampering with a witness.
