

I am writing in support of HB 6034.

To address those who wish to have their "day in the woods", I would like to point out that this bill concerns hunting on private land and if they are "having their day in the woods" on my family property then they are in fact trespassing on said private property. This bill has nothing to do with people's enjoyment of public parks and state forests.

I ask that the bill be amended to delete the following:

(1) Conduct such hunting only in deer management zones determined by the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection to be overpopulated and only in accordance with and pursuant to the wildlife management principles and practices established by the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection,
