Our members represent 156 towns and cities, representing over 95 percent of Connecticut's population. We appreciate the opportunity to testify on bills of interest to towns and cities.

HB 6838, "An Act Concerning the Encouragement of Local Economic Development and Access to Residential Renewable Energy"

CCM **supports** HB 6838.

HB 6838 would, among other things, provide incentives to stimulate greater investment of residential renewable energy. The bill would require the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority (PURA) provide an incentive, of up to five percent, for the use of major system components manufactured or assembled in a distressed municipality.

CCM urges the committee to favorably report HB 6838.
