Senate Bill No. 283

*Senate, March 12, 2015*

The Committee on Human Services reported through SEN. MOORE, M. of the 22nd Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

## ***AN ACT CONCERNING MEDICAID.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Commissioner of Social  
2 Services shall conduct a study of Medicaid programs administered  
3 under Title XIX of the Social Security Act. Such study shall include, but  
4 not be limited to, a report on: (1) Factors the commissioner deems  
5 pertinent to quality of care, (2) whether there are any gaps in access by  
6 eligible residents, and (3) whether any provisions of the program need  
7 to be changed in accordance with the Affordable Care Act, P.L. 111-  
8 148, as amended from time to time.

9 (b) Not later than July 1, 2016, the commissioner, in accordance with  
10 the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, shall report the  
11 results of the study done pursuant to subsection (a) of this section to  
12 the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having  
13 cognizance of matters relating to human services. Such report may  
14 include the commissioner's recommendations for addressing identified  
15 gaps in the provision of services and improving access to such

16 services.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
