Dear Mr. Hwang:

We are writing to support a bill to repeal the affordable housing land use appeals act, or, in lieu of repeal, modification of the General Statutes 8-30g and 8-30h to exempt municipalities with a watershed component of 50% or more, or with a population less than 10,000 residents, and to limit any development

on any watershed to 1 single-family residence per 3 upland acres in order to adequately protect the public water supply.

Also, we believe 8-30g should be amended to restrict its application to land within 2 miles of public transportation.
