
**SUPPORT of SB 1128, AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF

Dear Co-Chair Coleman, Co-Chair Tong, and Honorable Members of the Judiciary Committee,
Please accept this testimony in SUPPORT of HB 6187, which would establish a process
for appointing an advocate for an animal that is the subject of a criminal court
proceeding, and in SUPPORT of SB 1128, which would prevent persons charged with
committing animal abuse from using accelerated rehabilitation.

HB 6187 will help to facilitate animal cruelty prosecutions by ensuring appropriate
representation for the victims.

SB 1128 will help to ensure that violence toward animals is taken seriously and promotes
appropriately severe penalties as well as a record of these crimes in cases where people are
responsible for causing animals to suffer.
