**Subject:** SB 650, HB 6848, HB 6962

Please oppose the following bills: SB 650, HB 6848 and HB 6962.

SB 650, An Act Concerning Temporary Restraining Orders: Certainly no one wants to allow domestic violence. If there is a domestic violence situation, "common sense" would suggest that the "victim" be removed from the area where the violence is occurring. A victim can be killed by a knife, a club, a screw driver, a hammer or any number of objects. If a person feels that threatened, then they should remove themselves from that threat. It's "common sense". Taking guns away from duck hunters or turkey hunters will make no one safer. This propose law is arbitrary and vindictive and would be subject to frequent abuse with no remedy for the falsely accused. Please oppose SB 650.

HB 6848 would also give the same false sense of security to a victim of domestic violence. The only way to protect a victim of domestic violence is to remove that victim from the violent environment.

HB 6962. An Act Concerning Firearm Safety: Locking guns used for home protection would be the same as locking a police officer's gun and requiring the supervisor to appear on the scene with a key to unlock the officer's gun. When a group of thugs high on pcp breaks down your door at 2:00 A.M., the last thing you want to be doing is fumbling with a key or a combination to gain access to a tool that will save not only your life but the lives of your loved ones.
