



On Wednesday, March 18, the legislature's Judiciary Committee will hold a hearing on Bill 668 which would make assisted suicide legal in Connecticut.

Bill 668 would permit doctors to legally prescribe a lethal dose of medication to patients with less than six months to live.

I feel that Bill 668 would set a dangerous precedent for the way life is treated in Connecticut.

Lawmakers should instead be focusing on increasing access to hospice care, adequate staffing in nursing homes and required training in pain management.


I am a member of the Judiciary Committee and will be at the hearing, which should last all day at the Legislative Office Building in Hartford.




