Doctors need to honor this paragraph from the Oath they took: *"I will neither give a deadly drug to anybody who asked for it, nor will I make a suggestion to this effect. Similarly I will not give to a woman an abortive remedy. In purity and holiness I will guard my life and my art."*

May the senate affirm and support this oath.
