Dear Members of the Judiciary Committee,

- This bill adds manslaughter, persistent dangerous felons and sex offenders, aggravated sexual assault of a minor, and assault of pregnant woman resulting in loss of fetus as crimes for which a person cannot earn risk reduction credits.
- This bill would also require a prison warden to review and sign off on risk reduction credits earned by an inmate.
