Under our current system, violent felons who have been released early from prison have gone on to commit terrible crimes, including brutal murders.

On Wednesday, April 1, a public hearing will be held on a proposal which aims to reform the early release system.

- The bill adds manslaughter, persistent dangerous felons and sex offenders, aggravated sexual assault of a minor, and assault of pregnant woman resulting in loss of fetus as crimes for which a person **cannot** earn risk reduction credits.
- The bill would also require a prison warden to review and sign off on risk reduction credits earned by an inmate.




