Subject: Senate Bill 1129

Under our current early release system, violent felons who have been released early from prison have gone on to commit terrible crimes, including brutal murders.

On Wednesday, April 1, a public hearing will be held on a proposal which aims to reform the early release system.

- The bill adds manslaughter, persistent dangerous felons and sex offenders, aggravated sexual assault of a minor, and assault of pregnant woman resulting in loss of fetus as crimes for which a person **cannot** earn risk reduction credits.
- The bill would also require a prison warden to review and sign off on risk reduction credits earned by an inmate.

Please pass this bill and make our communities safer.
