

Greetings Senator Coleman and Representative Tong, and also all members of the Judiciary Committee,

While I sincerely wish that I could be there in person for this public hearing, my prior obligations could not be broken to do so.

With that said, I am asking you to oppose the appointment of Auden Grogins to the position of a Superior Court Judge.

While many legislators from both parties voted in favor of the passage of SB1160 (Gun Control Act 2013), Auden Grogins has introduced and/or co-sponsored numerous anti-2nd Amendment Bills throughout her various terms as a legislator:

HB6308 - AN ACT CONCERNING MILITARY STYLE WEAPONS.

HB6244 - AN ACT CONCERNING THE PURCHASE OF LONG GUNS AND LONG GUN AMMUNITION.

HB6245 - AN ACT REQUIRING THE REGISTRATION OF FIREARMS.

HB6246 - AN ACT CONCERNING THE SALE OF AMMUNITION FOR A PISTOL OR REVOLVER.

HB6250 - AN ACT CONCERNING CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECKS PRIOR TO THE SALE OR DELIVERY OF FIREARMS OTHER THAN HANDGUNS.

HB5951 - AN ACT PROHIBITING THE SALE OF FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION THROUGH THE INTERNET.

HB5955 - AN ACT CONCERNING THE SALE AND MANUFACTURE OF CERTAIN FIREARM MAGAZINES.

HB5956 - AN ACT CONCERNING RENEWAL OF PISTOL AND REVOLVER PERMITS.

HB6330 - AN ACT CONCERNING LOOK-A-LIKE FIREARMS.

There are serious concerns from myself and many members of the Connecticut Citizens Defense League which pertain to her ability to be fair and impartial with respect to our 2nd Amendment rights as citizens of this State.

Our Rights are clearly enumerated in the Constitution of our State, and the United States as well. People that swear an oath to uphold our rights seem to consider this act as merely going through a formal or celebratory motion. We as people which reside in our state deserve better much better the end result of this. The lives of good people are often in the hands of those that rule on certain cases. If our rights are merely subject to the whims elected or appointed officials, then what exactly is the point of swearing to that oath if it is ignored?

Tremendous damage was done regarding the trust of our State government by many in the past 2 years. I urge this committee to exercise a little bit of good natured rationale and move on to other options for Judges. This may restore some of the trust that many like I, wish to have in State Government.
