Addendum to Written Testimony in Opposition to the Re-Nomination of
Judge Taggart Adams:

Dear Members of the Judiciary Committee:

On Friday, January 23, 2015, Judge Taggart Adams was alleged to have delivered “material false” sworn testimony to the judiciary committee.

Senator Paul Doyle made comments concerning the “complexity” of a sixteen page letter which was not properly reviewed by the membership of the judiciary committee inasmuch as it was highly focused on matters involving Judge Thomas Parker on January 23, 2015.

In the “public hearing” portion of the judiciary committee’s review of Judge Taggart Adams, I verbally indicated to the committee members that Judge Adams had delivered “material false” statements to the judiciary committee in his sworn testimony.

Perjury is defined in Black’s Law Dictionary as follows:

“The act or an instance of a person’s deliberately making material false or misleading statements under an oath.”

Despite my appeals to the judiciary committee to table the vote on Judge Taggart Adams re-nomination, and provide a “due diligence” review of the discrepancy between Judge Adams statements and the transcripts of court proceedings delivered to the judiciary committee for review, a decision was made to move forward with Judge Adams vote at the judiciary committee for a resolution to support the nomination.

Notwithstanding the vote of the judiciary committee, the members of the House and Senate have yet to affirm the re-appointment of Judge Adams.

Therefore, I am requesting that the three page letter addressed to the Chief State Attorney Kevin Kane and Deputy Chief State Attorney Leonard Boyle and the

supporting eight page sworn affidavit delivered by hand to the Office of Chief State Attorney, be posted as an addendum to this letter.

Since the vote of the other members of the General Assembly is imminent, it is important for the members be provided, “the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth under the penalty of perjury”.

Please ensure the prompt posting on the judiciary website as an
