19 Sec. 502. Section 8-3f of the general statutes is repealed and the
20 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2015*):

21 [No community residence or child-care residential facility
22 established pursuant to section 8-3e] None of the following residences
23 or facilities shall be established within one thousand feet of any other
24 such [community residence or child-care residential] residence or
25 facility without the approval of the body exercising zoning powers
26 within the municipality in which such residence or facility is proposed
27 to be established: (1) Any community residence that houses six or
28 fewer persons with intellectual disability and necessary staff persons
29 and that is licensed under the provisions of section 17a-227, (2) any
30 child-care residential facility that houses six or fewer children with
31 mental or physical disabilities and necessary staff persons and that is
32 licensed under sections 17a-145 to 17a-151, inclusive, (3) any
33 community residence that houses six or fewer persons receiving
34 mental health or addiction services and necessary staff persons paid
35 for or provided by the Department of Mental Health and Addiction
36 Services and that has been issued a license by the Department of Public
37 Health under the provisions of section 19a-491 if a license is required,
38 or (4) any hospice facility, including a hospice residence, that provides
39 inpatient hospice care and services to six or fewer persons and is
40 licensed to provide such services by the Department of Public Health,
41 provided such facility is (A) managed by an organization that is tax
42 exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986,
43 or any subsequent corresponding internal revenue code of the United
44 States, as amended from time to time; (B) located in a city with a
45 population of more than one hundred thousand and within a zone that
46 allows development on one or more acres; and (C) served by public

47 sewer and water.

48 Sec. 503. Subsection (a) of section 17a-210d of the general statutes is
 49 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
 50 *October 1, 2015*):

51 (a) (1) Wherever the words "the mentally retarded" are used in the
 52 following general statutes, "persons with intellectual disability" or
 53 "individuals with intellectual disability" shall be substituted in lieu
 54 thereof; (2) wherever the words "mentally retarded", "mentally
 55 retarded person" or "mentally retarded persons" are used in the
 56 following general statutes, the words "intellectual disability", "person
 57 with intellectual disability" or "persons with intellectual disability"
 58 shall be substituted in lieu thereof; and (3) wherever the words "mental
 59 retardation" are used in the following general statutes, the words
 60 "intellectual disability" shall be substituted in lieu thereof: 4a-60, 4b-31,
 61 8-2g, [8-3e,] 9-159s, 10-91f, 17a-593, 17a-594, 17a-596, 45a-598, 45a-669,
 62 45a-672, 45a-676, 45a-677, 45a-678, 45a-679, 45a-680, 45a-681, 45a-682,
 63 45a-683, 46a-51, 46a-60, 46a-64, 46a-64b, 46a-66, 46a-70, 46a-71, 46a-72,
 64 46a-73, 46a-75, 46a-76, 46b-84, 52-146o, 53a-46a, 53a-181i and 54-250.
