"AN ACT CONCERNING CIVIL ACTIONS TO COLLECT PAST DUE PAYMENTS TO EMPLOYEE WELFARE FUNDS."

1 Strike section 1 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2015*) (a) For the purposes of
4 this section:

5 (1) "Employee" means any person engaged in service to a public
6 employer in a business of the public employer;

7 (2) "Employee welfare fund" has the same meaning as provided in
8 subsection (i) of section 31-53 of the general statutes; and

9 (3) "Public employer" means "employer" as defined in section 5-270
10 of the general statutes, or "municipal employer", as defined in section

11 7-467 of the general statutes.

12 (b) Any payment to an employee welfare fund that is past due
13 under the terms of a written contract or rules and regulations adopted
14 by the trustees of such funds shall be considered wages for the
15 purpose of section 31-72 of the general statutes, as amended by this act.

16 (c) (1) Any public employer who fails to make such payment when
17 due to an employee welfare fund under the terms of a written contract
18 or rules and regulations adopted by the trustees of such fund, or (2)
19 any employee of a public employer who has been designated by the
20 public employer to make such payment and who fails to make such
21 payment when due to an employee welfare fund shall be personally
22 liable in a civil action for payment of the amount due such fund, as
23 well as costs and reasonable attorney's fees."
