"AN ACT CONCERNING ELECTRIC RATE TRANSPARENCY."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Section 16-26 of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2015*):

5 [In] (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), in any matter within
6 the jurisdiction of the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority involving
7 rates, charges or accommodation of the public, the authority shall hold
8 at least one session of its hearings on such matter in a town within the
9 area served by the public service company concerned with such
10 matter, such town to be selected to suit as nearly as practicable the
11 convenience of persons affected by such matter. Upon petition of not
12 fewer than twenty-five persons affected by such matter, such a session

13 shall be held in the evening. The authority shall have the discretion to
14 hold the remainder of its hearings, if any, anywhere within the state of
15 Connecticut.

16 (b) In any matter within the jurisdiction of the authority involving
17 electric distribution company rates, charges or accommodation of the
18 public, the authority shall hold at least one session of its hearings on
19 such matter in three separate towns within the area served by the
20 electric distribution company concerned with such matter, such towns
21 to be selected to suit as nearly as practicable the convenience of
22 persons affected by such matter. Time shall be reserved at each hearing
23 session for public comment. Upon petition of not fewer than twenty-
24 five persons affected by such matter, such a session shall be held in the
25 evening. The authority shall have the discretion to hold the remainder
26 of its hearings, if any, anywhere within the state of Connecticut."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	October 1, 2015	16-26
