"AN ACT CONCERNING EDUCATION ISSUES."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subparagraph (E) of subdivision (8) of subsection (a) of
4 section 10-76d of the general statutes is repealed and the following is
5 substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2015*):

6 (E) Each local and regional board of education shall have in effect at
7 the beginning of each school year an educational program for each
8 child or pupil who has been identified as eligible for special education.
9 As part of such educational program, the board shall specify in writing
10 (i) the individuals who will provide services and support to each child
11 or pupil and whether such individuals are certified under chapter 166,
12 and (ii) the frequency and duration of such services and support. The
13 Commissioner of Education shall provide guidance to the local and
14 regional boards of education related to specifying the frequency and
15 duration of such services and support.

16 Sec. 2. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2015*) On an annual basis, the
17 Commissioner of Education shall conduct a random audit of (1) ten
18 educational programs as described in subparagraph (E) of subdivision
19 (8) of subsection (a) of section 10-76d of the general statutes, as
20 amended by this act, to ensure such educational programs are written
21 with specificity, and (2) ten local and regional boards of education to
22 ensure that individuals identified as possible substitute teachers by
23 such local and regional boards of education are qualified pursuant to
24 subsection (a) of section 10-145 of the general statutes to be substitute
25 teachers and that the number of individuals identified as possible
26 substitute teachers provides sufficient substitute teacher coverage
27 given the number of students of such local and regional boards of
28 education."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
